



LETTER OF REFERENCE

This letter has been issued for the purpose of providing a reference for the Latvian Turkish Chamber of Commerce (LVTCC), which has been established in Latvia and has officially commenced its activities.

The Latvian Turkish Chamber of Commerce is an independent, non-profit organization aiming to promote the development of commercial, economic, and institutional relations between Türkiye and Latvia, and to bring together the business communities of both countries. The Chamber operates with the objective of supporting sustainable business cooperation among entrepreneurs, investors, and institutions, encouraging mutual investment and trade opportunities, and establishing a constructive communication platform between public institutions and the private sector.

Throughout its establishment and structuring process, it has been observed that LVTCC has been organized in line with the principles of transparency, institutional integrity, and long-term cooperation, and that it continues its activities with the support of Turkish businesspeople in Latvia and representatives of the Latvian business community.
